Introduction

The Primary Health Care (PHC) area of Corner Brook-Bay of Islands (CBBOI) is inclusive of the city of Corner Brook, the towns of Massey Drive, Gallants, and Steady Brook, and all communities within the north and south shores of the Bay of Islands. Communities along the north shore of the Bay of Islands include: Hughes Brook, Irishtown - Summerside, Meadows, Gilliams, McIvers and Cox's Cove. Communities along the south shore of the Bay of Islands include: Mt. Moriah, Halfway Point, Benoit's Cove, John's Beach, Frenchman's Cove, York Harbour and Lark Harbour. Corner Brook, being the largest municipality in this PHC area, is the regional center for services and businesses including Western Memorial Regional Hospital, a regional hospital for all residents of the western region. The distance between Corner Brook and the farthest community on the north shore of the Bay of Islands is 38.8 km whereas the distance between Corner Brook and the farthest community on the south shore of the Bay of Islands is 47 km. The majority of residents of this PHC area travel to Corner Brook for most of their service needs.

Community assets include anything that can be used to improve the quality of community life. This may include things such as a physical structure or place, community service or health service. The PHC community assets provide insight into the resources that communities have available to them to support health and wellness. Community assets can be used as a foundation for community improvement. Understanding a community's strengths makes it easier to understand what kinds of programs or initiatives might be possible to address the community's needs. The purpose of this community asset listing is to identify the assets available in the CBBOI Primary Health Care Area. It is recognized that while this listing may not include every community asset, it should provide an overview of the major assets available within a health region, with a focus on health and community resources that support individuals and communities in maintaining a safe and healthy environment. Please find below the community assets summary of the CBBOI Primary Health Care area.

Community Assets Listing

Health Related Assets

Western Memorial Regional Hospital, located in Corner Brook, is a 217 bed facility providing a comprehensive range of inpatient and outpatient services to the people of the Western region, approximately 78,000 people. It is the major acute health center for the region. The Health

Services provided are comprehensive and family physicians are supported by specialist services in: Cardiology, Geriatrics, Internal Medicine and Surgery, Nephrology, Neurology, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Pediatrics, Psychiatry, Urology.

The Corner Brook Long Term Care Home (CBLTC) is a 250 bed facility that provides a range of services to its residents. The three main programs offered within this facility include Long Stay Program, Restorative Care, Protective Care and Respite Care. The Long Term Stay Program offers permanent care to individuals who are no longer capable of living in their own home or community, Restorative Care program provides slow paced rehabilitative care for adults 65+ following a stay in acute care. The Protective Care program is for those individuals experiencing severe cognitive impairment which warrants a secure, dementia specific environment for residents who are mobile without aids. The Respite Care program provides care for a brief predetermined period of time for caregivers and is accessible pending bed availability. Protective Community Residences are also available as an enhanced assisted living for individuals with mild to moderate dementia.

Private health services centrally located in Corner Brook but service the CBBOI primary health care area. These services are varied and include, but are not limited to disciplines as physiotherapy, occupational therapy, chiropractors, dentists etc. In addition, there are also a number of Wellness Centers which offer a broad range of services from fitness to on site physicians.

There are a number of Provincial programs and services that are accessible to all residents of the province by way of toll free numbers, mobile apps and the internet. These programs include the Newfoundland and Labrador Health Line, Smokers' Helpline, Gambling Help Line, Planned Parenthood Sexual Health Center, Bridge the Gapp, and Strongest Families.

Education

There are ten schools in the CBBOI area that include primary/elementary, junior high school, high school and two all grade schools. There is one private school which includes junior kindergarten to grade 8. There are three public post-secondary schools in Corner Brook. Grenfell Campus of Memorial University Newfoundland enrolls approximately 1300 students in degree programs including arts, education, fine arts, science, nursing and resource management. Western Regional School of Nursing (WRSON) enrolls approximately 50 nursing students per year as part of a collaborative program in partnership with Grenfell Campus and Memorial University. College of the North Atlantic registers 700 full time students per semester, with another 100 registered part-time. The College of the North Atlantic also supports an additional 1,200 students in Corner Brook and offers a variety of one and two year diploma programs. There are several licensed private Day Cares in the area that provide regulated care to children in a child care provider's own home.

Recreation and Leisure Facilities and Organizations

Access to recreation and leisure is very important for the health of communities. There is infrastructure and facilities to support organized and competitive sport such as figure skating, soccer, curling, gymnastics and martial arts; recreation activities such as hiking, trails and skateboard parks and leisure activities such as movie theatres and community clubs. As well, there are opportunities to partake in the arts ranging from painting and other mediums of art expression to performance art and theatre. The CBBOI area is rich in opportunities for outdoor activities on land and water. There is an abundance of trails, parks and outdoor spaces as well as, rivers, lakes and ponds for water sport and recreation. The International Appalachian Trail System of Newfoundland and Labrador includes four marked trails for the adventurous hiker directly in the CBBOI area. There are a number of health and fitness centres that offer fitness classes and gym facilities. The Humber YMCA is a non-profit organization which offers both fitness and community programs and offers membership assistance to those who may not otherwise be able to participate. Conclusion

The Primary Health Care area for Corner Brook-Bay of Islands includes eight municipalities: Corner Brook, Massey Drive, Steady Brook, Irishtown-Summerside, Hughes Brook, Gillams, Meadows, McIvers and the residents of Little Rapids, Humber village and Pinchgut Lake. Corner Brook is the main hub for most health related services, although other programs such as Community Supports offers home based services to clients. There is a wide array of health services in the area including medical specialities, physician services, dental, pharmacy, physiotherapy, occupational therapy and massage therapy. Residents of CBBOI utilize most health services in Corner Brook but may have to travel to St. John's for other specialist services that are not available locally. The area includes both public and private secondary and post-secondary institutions, churches and many community groups and non-profit organizations which all contribute to the health of the area. Many programs and services in the area are provided by local volunteers who support fire departments, social and seniors clubs, youth groups and sports and recreation.

The Corner Brook- Bay of Islands area provides an opportunity for many outdoor pursuits both on land and in the water. From downhill skiing on Marble Mountain, hiking on the many trails, boating on the rivers and lakes, the CBBOI area offers people a chance to connect with nature.
