


SEARCH THE INTERNET


SATISFACTION

Majority (66%) of respondents indicated they were able to access a required health service

TOP THREE COMMUNITY CONCERNS:

- 1. Addictions (27%)

TOP THREE BEHAVIORS TO IMPROVE HEALTH:

- 1. Physical activity (88%)
- 2. Eat healthier (83%)
- 3. Reduce stress (81%)
