#### WHO ARE WE?

Speech-Language Pathologists are health care professionals who help people with difficulties related to communication and swallowing. We provide assessment, therapy, and consultation services for:

- -speech
- -language
- -stuttering
- -voice
- -swallowing (Adults only)





### WHAT SERVICES DO WE PROVIDE?

## Assessment, therapy and general information for clients having difficulties:

- Saying words and sentences clearly
- Learning new words, or recalling the names of things
- Putting words together to make sentences
- Understanding the meaning of words and sentences
- Using your voice box (e.g. voice box removed, vocal nodules, hoarse voice)
- Stuttering
- Swallowing (Adults only)

### Some causes of speech, language and swallowing difficulty include:

- Autism
- Down Syndrome
- Cerebral Palsy
- Cleft Lip or Palate
- Family History
- General delay in child's development
- Parkinson's Disease
- Multiple Sclerosis
- Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS or Lou Gehrig's Disease)
- Stroke
- Head Injury
- Hearing Loss

In many cases, there is no known cause.
