


#### **HEALTH INFORMATION**

Majority (69%) of respondents search the internet when they are looking for health related information


## **HEALTH SERVICES**

Majority (62%) of respondents were satisfied or very satisfied with health care services they used in the past 12 months


### **ACCESS**
